Through this session, students learned about the importance of soft skills in exploring a career.

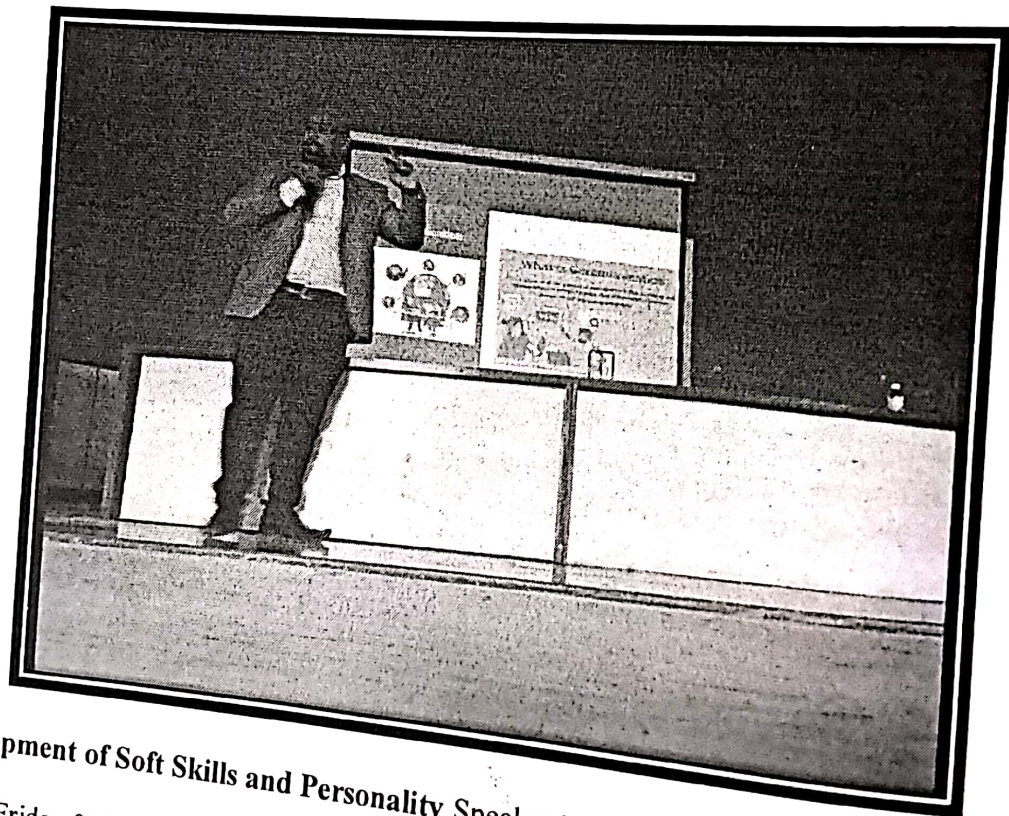
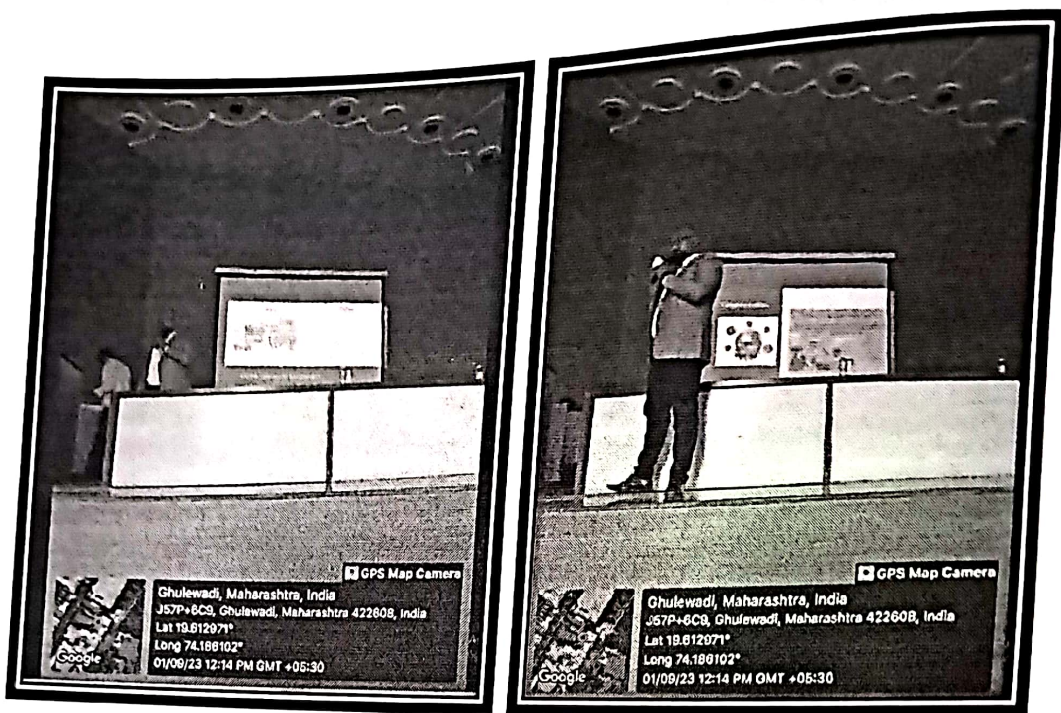
