In this era of digitalisation and Internet if we can connect these villages and rural India with the mainstream, We can make the dream become the reality.

Officially India has about 6,40,000 villages approximately and almost 68% of the population is living in these villages. We intend to focus on this area as it has immensely talented and practical youth but is latent potential of India.

Now, lets have an idea about how we intend to do it.

I. I. We have created a website called MAZA GAON SUKEWADI. Through which we connected with people of this particular village. Every place has some kind of historical importance, a different culture, history and trends of living life. We studied that and made it available on our website in order to conserve it. Plus we gathered youth in order to connect with this website in various mediums. The youth contributed in making the Gramsabha online and available not only to the naive people but also to the people who are originated here but migrated because of few reasons. This began a new era of transparency in the dialogue between Govt and people. We also made a platform for the farmers as well as businesses who can operate through our site whiteout giving a penny to us. Big example of that is a farmer getting order of animal food(hay) from NANDED, THANE, GUJRAT and so on may more.

- 2. We are also engaged in literacy programs and promoting the importance of the literacy. Also to address the main issue of migration due to job unavailability in the village, we have launched a new skill development mission. Here we appealed donors to donate us computers and parts of computers irrespective of the functionality. So from this mission we accomplished two things_I. We are teaching basic computer handling to all age groups of the village with the function-able units. @. We are teaching students and youth about the hardware that is used in the computers with the non function-able units with which they can get an option of employment.
- 3. A lot has been said about the BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO concept. We have taken this in our hands and we are performing as well as contributing the fact to the villagers. We strongly believe that a woman can achieve great heights if they are provided with the freedom and knowledge. Also we are promoting the government schemes through seminars and different activities.
- 4. In near future we also intent to make Agro tourism as well as the Village tourism happen which can create employment as well as the financial cycle of the village will get a boost. Additionally the migration from villages to cities can be minimised if we can create the option of employment.
- 5. We are working on a CLUSTURE INTEGRATION MODEL which will gather the masses and display the different schemes of Govt of India which facilitates small businesses as well as farmers. WQe are working on making this display on our site under one roof. Because we think govt is launching a lot of schemes which can help to create mass employment but the problem is these schemes do not reach to the masses.
- 6. Literacy programmes for adults- We are successfully taking the seminars as well as teaching sessions for the adults who are illiterate. Because if a person can read and write he/she will no longer be prone to the fraudulent people and can successfully mark their way up.
- 7. Along with all this we are also sitting up a library in sukewadi for which the Grampanchayt has allocated a land and we are collecting different kind of donations from different donors. Here also we are trying to implement the 3way model of donations but differently. The donations are accepted in three forms- 1.Books, stationary, Furniture.
 2. Sweat donation- We are setting up a building which is totally constructed with the help of students, villagers and MAZA GAON FOUNDATION volunteers.
