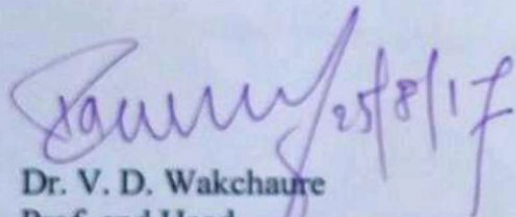

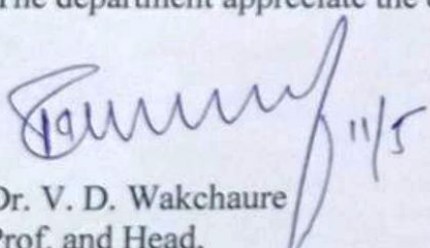

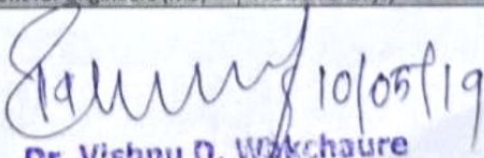

Participants: SE, E&TC students

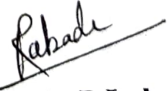
Objectives:

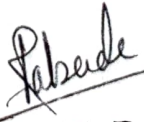
